Westmorland Chamber of Commerce 14th Annual Honey Festival Spelling Bee Rules

1. When it is your turn to spell the word, please stand and make your way to the microphone stand at the front of the main staging area.
2. When you miss a word, please make your way off the staging area to join the audience.
3. It is suggested that the contestant say the word before spelling it and after. However, the contestant will not be disqualified for not saying the word.
4. No wrong letters may be used in the spelling of a word.
5. As long as no wrong letter is used, a contestant may repeat the letters to spell the word correctly.
6. The contestant may ask for a definition or for the use of the word in a sentence.
7. Capital letters and hyphens must be acknowledged when spelling in order for the word to be correct.
8. In terms of a misspelled word, it will be necessary for the last person standing to spell the missed word and one more word to be declared the champion.
9. In case a word is misunderstood and spelled in a different tense, as long as that word is spelled correctly, the proctor will give the word again, using a sentence.
